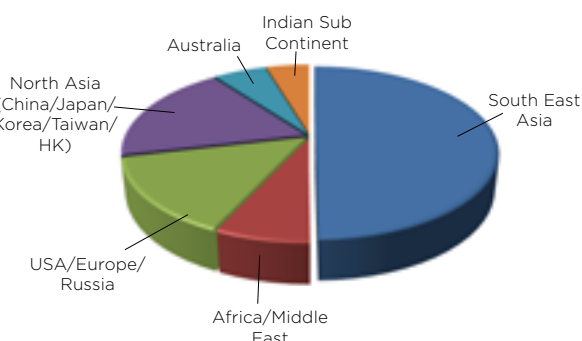

2018 has been another year of strong growth for LNG with production of around 315 mt, an increase of 25 mt (8.6%) compared with 2017. Australia and the USA have again been the main sources of supply growth and Russia has also made a strong contribution as production has built-up from Yamal LNG. Amongst the established producers, Oman and Trinidad have increased exports as new upstream production has been brought on-line and Egypt is expected to once again become a net LNG exporter as production increases from recently discovered offshore natural gas reserves. At the end of November 2018, a further 85 mtpa of liquefaction capacity was under construction, 53 mt of which is scheduled to start-up by the end of 2019. LNG production in 2019 is expected to increase by around 40 mt, the largest ever addition to LNG supply in a single year. The growth in production will slow from 2020 because of the lack of final investment decisions (FIDs) on new capacity in 2016 and 2017.

The main markets for incremental supply in 2017 and 2018 have been Asia, with China leading the way as its imports more than doubled to 53 mtpa. However, as the demand for LNG continues to grow, there will be a shortfall in LNG supply after 2022 if FIDs on new liquefaction capacity are not taken in the next 12 to 18 months. Around 500 mtpa of new liquefaction capacity, over 50% of which is in the USA, is currently being planned. The developers of 200 mtpa of new capacity are saying that they expect to take FID on their projects by the end of 2020. The prospects of the targets being met will be discussed and forecasts will be presented of LNG supply and demand to 2030.

Price will be a major consideration for buyers in deciding which projects they select amongst the many on offer and will be critical to the economic viability of new projects. Oil indexation, which according to the annual review of pricing by the International Gas Union (IGU) is the basis on which over 73% of LNG was sold in 2017, is coming under pressure as buyers seek prices that more closely reflect the value of natural gas in their downstream markets. The workshop will review recent movements in LNG prices, the future of oil indexation and the alternatives of market-based prices - a linkage to Henry Hub prices or to prices at other hubs, such as the UK's National Balancing Point - and the role of the Japan Korea Marker (JKM) and other assessments in pricing spot and short-term LNG in Asia. The workshop will also consider the implications of the increasing share of spot and short-term LNG in the global market.

A key objective of the workshop is to provide delegates with an overview of the supply and pricing outlook in advance of the main conference, where they will be key topics in the presentations and discussion.
