



## LNGA 2022 Travel, Health and Safety Advisory

Thank you for your registration of the **16<sup>th</sup> LNG Supplies for Asian Market 2022**. As the health & safety of our delegates are of paramount importance, we are pleased to provide details of steps and procedures put in place to ensure the safest environment possible is created for our attendees. Registered delegates are required to take note and adhere to the following event requirements and safe management measures under the Safe Business Events Framework provided by the Singapore Tourism Board (**STB**):-

### Singapore Travel Advisory Updates

Singapore has implemented Safe Travel Lanes to facilitate travel while safeguarding public health amidst the COVID-19 pandemic.

Travellers who need to only make a short-term visit to Singapore may use the lanes below. Only travellers with travel history to the listed countries/regions before arriving in Singapore may use the respective lanes.

## Full Details of Requirements

- a) **Full Vaccination** - All participants are required to be fully vaccinated to attend the conference. There are 2 levels of the vaccination regime:-
- Primary vaccination series** - You have received the full regimen of either Pfizer-BioNTech/Comirnaty, Moderna, or WHO EUL vaccines, with an additional two weeks for the vaccine to be fully effective and
  - Booster Vaccination** – You have received your booster vaccination within 270 days (9 months) after the last dose in your primary vaccination series. Upon receiving your booster, you will continue to be considered as fully vaccinated beyond the 270 days. (see '[Notes](#)' at the end of this document for definition of the primary vaccination series and the booster vaccination, as well as a booster dose timing example)

or

- b) **Recovered** from COVID-19 – within the 180-day exemption period after recovery from COVID-19.
- c) **Proof of Vaccination/Recovered Status** – will be requested when you come for registration on 24 March. Please bring along an acceptable document indicating your vaccination status such as a Vaccination Certificate issued by the Ministry of Health (MOH) (corresponding to the name used for your registration of the Forum), or your Trace Together Token or App indicating your vaccination status or a discharge memo to show that you have recovered from COVID.

*The IT systems at Immigration have been enhanced such that travellers, upon verification of their eligible vaccination status at entry, will also be recognised by SE Biz App through their TT apps/ Tokens to be eligible for vaccination-differentiated safe management measures without needing to go through PET.*

- d) **TraceTogether (TT) only SafeEntry** - All Singapore resident participants are required to bring along their Trace Together Tokens or updated apps on their mobile phones and use “TraceTogether (TT)-only SafeEntry” check-in for entry into and exit from the event venue or any premises in the event itinerary (including an event hall, a meeting room or a function room). - e) **Safe Distancing and Good Hygiene Practices** - Participants are reminded to practice safe distancing and good hygiene practices which include:-
- Being masked at all times, except when having meals (see below conditions for meals)
  - Safe distancing is encouraged but not required between individuals or groups in all mask-on settings.

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3. There will be no intermingling between the unmasked speakers and participants during the event.
4. The hotel will be adhering to the latest advisory from the National Environment Agency (NEA) as well as the SG Clean MICE Venues checklist for ensuring a safe and clean environment for participants and in particular agents such as hand sanitisers, disinfectant sprays, paper towels and wipes will be made available for free use by participants and staff at event spaces, including near high-touch surfaces such as handrails, door handles, interactive kiosks and lift buttons.

f) **Conditions for All Meals** (including tea breaks) - where individuals are permitted to remove their masks, the following shall apply:

1. A distance of at least 1 metre between groups of up to 5 participants must be maintained at all times. The number of participants in each group must not exceed 5
2. Participants must be seated when consuming or about to consume the meal. To avoid doubt, participants must remain in the same table throughout the meal duration and must not intermingle with any individual of another table while the meal is being served/consumed.
3. Meals must only be consumed when participants are and remain seated.
4. Meals will be plated and served at each seat with no self-service options.
5. There must be no cheering or other verbal exhortations accompanied by toasting or other rituals during meals
6. Individuals must remain in the same table where a meal is consumed throughout the meal
7. Each table of participants must not intermingle with any individual of another table while the meal is being served/consumed.
8. Participants must remain in their seats where there are live speeches, talks, presentations and/or panel discussions during meals taking place, individuals must remain in their seats during this period.
9. Participants must remain masked when not consuming food and beverages

g) **Photography** – Participants cannot unmask if photos are taken by the Event Organiser or other participants. If photos are taken by the official event photographer, the number of unmasked participants will be no more than 10 at any one time with at least 1 metre spacing between the unmasked participants at all times. Participants may only unmask during the take/shot and must promptly put their masks back on in between shots.

### **Additional Requirements to be Observed by Registered Delegates**

- a) **Pre-Registration** – All participants will be required to pre-register prior to event start date; walk-in registrations will not be entertained.
- b) **Quarantine Order, Isolation Order or Health Risk Warning** - The event organisers will not allow entry of any individual who is known to be under a Quarantine

- d) **Emergency Response Plan** – The event organisers will be maintaining a response plan for participants or staff who are found to display COVID-19 symptoms including:-
1. Seeking medical treatment for any such participants at the nearest medical facilities in accordance with the requirements of the Ministry of Health
  2. Working with the venue to adhere to NEA's [latest guidelines](#) for environmental cleaning and disinfection of areas exposed to confirmed cases of COVID-19

### Notes

**Primary Vaccination Series** is defined as 14 days after the final dose of the vaccine

**WHO-EUL listed vaccines**<sup>1</sup>

- Pfizer-BioNtech/Comirnaty
- Moderna
- Johnson & Johnson/Janssen
- Oxford-AstraZeneca/Vaxzevria
- Serum Institute of India/Covishield
- Sinopharm
- Sinovac

All WHO-EUL vaccines require two doses of the same type of vaccine except for Johnson & Johnson/Janssen, which requires only one dose. Sinovac-CoronaVac/Sinopharm vaccines may require 3 doses as part of their primary vaccination series.

### **Booster Dose Required to Maintain Fully Vaccinated Status**

From 14 February 2022 onwards, persons aged 18 years and above who have completed the primary vaccination series of COVID-19 vaccines and are eligible for booster vaccination will be considered as fully vaccinated for 270 days after the last dose in their primary vaccination series. They should then receive their booster vaccination from around 5 months thereafter as recommended and no later than 270 days thereafter, to ensure an optimal level of protection and to be considered as fully vaccinated. Upon receiving their booster, they will continue to be considered as fully vaccinated beyond the 270 days

#### Booster Dose Timing Example

If an individual completed his primary vaccination series on 1 June 2021, he would be eligible for a booster vaccination 5 months later, i.e. from 1 November 2021 onwards, and would have to receive his booster by 26 February 2022 to continue to be considered as fully vaccinated.
